## YHEC GENERAL VOLUNTEER INFORMATION/CODE OF CONDUCT & RELEASE

As a member of the YHEC volunteer team, you will become an integral part of a volunteer program management plan – such plans in the past have influenced future programs, policies, and procedures of the NRA. Applicants must demonstrate leadership, versatility, specific skills (as outlined in volunteer positions overviews) and dedication. In an effort to ensure a positive, successful experience for volunteers and this educational program, the following guidelines have been established.

To become a YHEC general volunteer, individuals must:

1. Complete YHEC Volunteer Application in its entirety.
2. Be at least eighteen (18) years of age upon execution of the YHEC Volunteer Application
3. Possess knowledge, background, and required skills for available volunteer positions. (NOTE: specific requirements are detailed in related volunteer position overviews.)
4. Accept direction from NRA staff and assigned supervisors (where applicable) and follow established program organizational structure.
5. Comply fully with NRA's professional standards, policies, and procedures as they may pertain to conduct and appearance.
6. Refrain from consumption of alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs during the YHEC program. (Event sites may dictate further restrictions above and beyond daily event schedule.)
7. Participate fully in assigned activities.
8. Know and follow all rules, regulations and procedures (including those set forth in the *Official Rules and Regulations*) pertaining to the YHEC event.
9. Always follow NRA's rules of firearms safety.
10. Notify NRA staff, when situations occur that require attention.
11. Manage and secure all NRA finances (when applicable), materials and equipment responsibly or in a responsible manner.
12. Refrain from acting as a spokesperson for the NRA or from expressing personal opinions on NRA issues during volunteer assignments.
